Our new mobile clinic allows Kentucky Children's Hospital to bring leading-edge care to children throughout the state.

Too often, children and teens can't get to Lexington to get the specialized care they need. A new mobile clinic operated by Kentucky Children's Hospital – the Colonel Harland Sanders Foundation Mobile Clinic – brings the care to them.

The new clinic transports providers from several pediatric specialties to regional hospitals, local schools, events and other community locations in Kentucky. The clinic is staffed by a practice manager, nurse, nurse manager, medical assistant and dedicated driver.

The clinic includes several features that make it inviting and accessible:

- Child-friendly interior and exterior design
- Sensory devices for children with anxiety or unique developmental needs
- Satellite Internet access
- Power awning for expanded registration and waiting
- Electric ADA ramp
- Interpreter and telemedicine services available via iPads and laptops.
